**Dislocated Worker** – Individuals who meet one or more of the following criteria:

<u>Category 1:</u> Terminated or laid-off AND eligible for or exhausted unemployment compensation AND unlikely to return to previous industry or occupation.

<u>Category 2:</u> Terminated, laid-off, has received notice of termination or layoff, and has been employed for sufficient duration. Not eligible for UC and is unlikely to return to industry or occupation.

<u>Category 3:</u> Terminated, laid-off, received notice, has received notice of termination or impending layoff due to permanent plant closure or substantial layoff at plant facility or enterprise.

**<u>Category 4</u>**: Employer has made a general announcement that the facility or plant will close within 180 days. An individual terminated, laid-off or notified of layoff or closure and is eligible for or has exhausted unemployment compensation benefits.

Category 5: Previously self-employed but currently unemployed due to the economy or natural disaster

**<u>Category 6</u>**: Displaced Homemaker – has been dependent on the income of another family member, but is no longer being supported by the income AND is unemployed or underemployed, AND is experiencing difficulty obtaining or upgrading employment.

**<u>Category 7:</u>** Loss of employment due to spouse's active military duties.

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
