## Employment and Training Opportunity Program




#### Who are we?

CareerSource Escarosa is a non-profit employment and training organization committed to supporting the workforce needs of Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties.

The goal of our Welfare Transition Program (WTP) is to emphasize work, self-sufficiency, and personal responsibility. The end result is to enable individuals to make the transition from welfare to work.

To accomplish this goal, CareerSource Escarosa has developed a work experience program that serves as a win-win for both the individual and the employer.

Through the Employment and Training Opportunity Program, the employer receives an intern (for a specified period of time) at no charge and the individual gains valuable training.



## **Employer Benefits:**

- Serves as a great trial period if you have a current job opening.
- No payroll expenses
- Worker's Compensation covered by the State of Florida for all program participants
- Provides an opportunity to observe a participant's work ethic including; attendance, reliability, dependability, productivity, as well as his or her ability to learn and function as part of a team.
- Substantial tax breaks through the Work Opportunity Tax Credit (WOTC).

## Guidelines for Employer Participation:

- Provide the necessary instructions, supervision, and equipment to train the individual as assigned as part of designated job duties.
- Provide timely feedback on the participant's performance
- Treat the individual the same as your paid employees
- Sign weekly timesheets provided by the Welfare Transition Program (WTP).
